Registration:

REGISTRATION IS ONLINE ONLY

MUST BE RECEIVED BY 5PM ON THE WEDNESDAY BEFORE EVENT!! (Wednesday, May 8th)
IN THE SUBJECT YOU MUST HAVE CLUB NAME, GENDER, AGE, TEAM ID (NUMBER THAT STARTS WITH JAGSSPRING) Example: MICHIGAN JAGUARS Boys U8 JAGSSPRING55555555 Send as one continuous document if able and preferably a PDF file.

What you need to EMAIL:

1. Passcards, picture side only
2. Copy of your league/state roster
3. Guest player roster if applicable (you can get this from your state association)
4. Copy of Risk Management Card for Coach (kid safe card or equivalent issued by state or province)
5. Copy of Safe Sport Certificate for Coach (safe practices or equivalent)
6. Copy of Coaching Concussion Certificate (concussion training or equivalent)
7. Liability Release Form (found on website)
8. Copy of travel permit, (applies to out of state teams and teams from Canada unless traveling as US Club Soccer)
9. Medical Release form (PLEASE DO NOT SEND JUST HAVE ON YOU) This form is provided by your state association or league.
MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS: YOU DO NOT HAVE TO PROVIDE A COPY, JUST MAKE SURE YOU HAVE THEM ON YOU AT ALL TIMES IN CASE OF AN INJURY

If you have guest players it is a state sanctioning rule that you must fill out a guest player roster with your state affiliate, we do not supply those forms. For Michigan you can go to https://www.michiganyouthsoccer.org/Member_Services/Guest_Player_Forms.htm and click Forms, e-travel forms. Other states must go to your state affiliate to get your forms.

FAQ's

1. Can a player, play for more than one team?

YES!! IMPORTANT: Players are now allowed to play for more than 1 team in the tournament.

2. Can my team register at the field or on Saturday morning?

NO!! Even if your team is playing a game on Friday evening, you **MUST REGISTER** your team online **ONLY, NO EXCEPTIONS**, so please plan accordingly!!

3. Does everyone playing have to have a passcard or is a birth certificate okay?

YES!! *Everyone must have a passcard to play, that is how we know they are properly insured and no, a birth certificate is NOT accepted in place of a passcard.*

4. How do I go about obtaining a passcard if a player does not have?

5. Can players help out (sub) on other teams?
